St. Louis, MO – (March 8, 2018) Following careful consideration by the Board of Directors, New Florence Care Center joined the St. Andrew's Resources for Seniors System family effective March 1, 2018, and will henceforth be known as St. Andrew's at New Florence.

St. Andrew's at New Florence was opened in 1975 as a 60-bed, non-profit Skilled Nursing Community, thanks to the efforts of the citizens of New Florence and Montgomery County, as well as the Charles S. Cardwell family, who donated the land for the building. In 1987, a 20-bed Intermediate Care wing and a 40-bed Residential Care Level II wing were added to the community. St. Andrew's Resources for Seniors System took over management in 1996, and has partnered with them through many changes, including a successful Bond Issue acquired through the Industrial Development Association of Montgomery County.

At the end of 2017, the Board of Directors at New Florence wanted to undertake a modernization campaign and realized that the best way to accomplish that goal was to become part of a larger senior service organization. They wanted to ensure that the community retained their original non-profit mission of serving the residents of Montgomery County. Having enjoyed a successful two-decade partnership with St. Andrew's Resources for Seniors System, the Board decided to become an official part of the St. Andrew's family.

St. Andrew's Resources for Seniors System has served the citizens of Missouri and Illinois for over 55 years and brings to the table a wealth of experience in project management, modernization efforts, and a holistic belief in caring for all elders. St. Andrew's at New Florence looks forward to continuing their tradition of service while offering local residents new and exciting possibilities allowing more seniors to remain in their hometown as they age.
